- **Note:** The section-wise distribution in the above table is indicative. Actual papers may vary.
- **Negative Marking:** 1/3 mark deduction for each wrong answer.

The 1st Stage CBT is of **screening nature**. The questions will be in conformity with the educational standards prescribed for the posts. The **normalized score** will be used to shortlist candidates for the 2nd Stage CBT based on merit.

Candidates availing reservation benefits under **OBC(NCL)/SC/ST/EWS, PwBD, and ExSM** will continue to be considered under their respective categories in all subsequent recruitment stages.

Syllabus:

- **Mathematics:**
 - Number System, Decimals, Fractions, LCM, HCF, Ratio and Proportions, Percentage, Mensuration, Time and Work, Time and Distance, Simple and Compound Interest, Profit and Loss, Elementary Algebra, Geometry and Trigonometry, Elementary Statistics, etc.

- **General Intelligence & Reasoning:**
 - Analogies, Completion of Number and Alphabetical Series, Coding and Decoding, Mathematical Operations, Similarities and Differences, Relationships, Analytical Reasoning, Syllogism, Jumbling, Venn Diagrams, Puzzle, Data Sufficiency, Statement-Conclusion, Statement-Courses of Action, Decision Making, Maps, Interpretation of Graphs, etc.
- **General Awareness:**
 - Current Events (National & International), Games and Sports, Art and Culture of India, Indian Literature, Monuments and Places of India, General Science and Life Science (up to 10th CBSE), History of India and Freedom Struggle, Geography (India & World), Indian Polity and Governance, General Scientific Developments, Space and Nuclear Program of India, UN and Other World Organizations, Environmental Issues, Basics of Computers, Transport Systems, Indian Economy, Famous Personalities, Flagship Government Programs, Flora and Fauna of India, Government/Public Sector Organizations, etc.

Eligibility Criteria (Minimum Percentage of Marks):

- UR/EWS: 40%
- OBC (Non-Creamy Layer): 30%
- SC: 30%
- ST: 25%

Note: PwBD candidates may receive a relaxation of 2 marks if there is a shortage of PwBD candidates.

2nd Stage Computer Based Test (CBT)

Shortlisting for the 2nd Stage CBT will be based on the **normalized marks** from the 1st Stage CBT. The total number of candidates shortlisted will be 15 times the community-wise vacancies, but this may be adjusted as per the Railways' requirements.

- **General Intelligence & Reasoning:**
 - Same as the 1st Stage CBT.
- **General Awareness:**
 - Same as the 1st Stage CBT.

Eligibility Criteria (Minimum Percentage of Marks):

- UR/EWS: 40%
- OBC (Non-Creamy Layer): 30%
- SC: 30%
- ST: 25%

Note: PwBD candidates may receive a relaxation of 2 marks if there is a shortage of PwBD candidates.

Typing Skill Test (TST)

Posts: Account Clerk Cum Typist & Junior Clerk Cum Typist

- **Typing Requirements:**
 - English: 30 Words Per Minute (WPM)
 - Hindi: 25 WPM (using Kruti Dev or Mangal font)
- **Exemption:** Candidates with disabilities (40% or more) may be exempted from the Typing Skill Test if they submit a valid medical exemption certificate.

Candidates who qualify for the Typing Skill Test will be selected based on their performance in the 2nd Stage CBT. Marks obtained in the TST will not be added to the merit list.
